- Call to Order President Paul Bouknight called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
- Minutes Rusty Sox distributed revised minutes of the November 11 meeting. Susan Creed moved to approve the minutes, Sandra Ligon seconded and the minutes were approved.
- North Main Street Revitalization Fred Monk is heading up a committee to encourage the city to carry out streetscaping between Elmwood Ave. and Sunset before money runs out on the Columbia College end of the project. Paul Bouknight will represent Cottontown at the initial meeting.
- Membership Drive Paul Bouknight will send a reminder to expired members to renew their memberships. He asked each board member to speak with their neighbors and personally encourage residents to join.
