| Call to Order | President Paul Bouknight called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. He distributed copies of the agenda and the minutes of the May 2, 2006 meeting. |
| Motion | Ms. Cooper moved to approve the minutes of May 2. Mr. Sockwell seconded, and the minutes were approved. |
| Bylaws Revisions | There was discussion about the process to be followed during the upcoming special meeting to vote on changes to the bylaws. |
| Motion | Mr. Sockwell moved to set the date of the special meeting for Sunday, August 13, 2006 at 3:00 p.m. Ms. Hall seconded and the motion was approved. |
| Zoning Issues | Mr. Bouknight reported that the Board of Zoning Appeals had approved the zoning variance for the woodworking shop at 2327 Main Street, and had denied the variance for the proposed Cash Advance store at 2321 Main Street. There was discussion of buying a copy of the zoning code for the use of the neighborhood. |
| Crime Watch | Mr. Bouknight reported on his attendance at a meeting of North Main Street neighborhood officers regarding crime in the area. He learned that, when making reports about theft in the neighborhood, residents should file a <u>police report</u> vs. an <u>informational</u> report. |
| National Night Out | Mr. Bouknight announced that National Night Out would be observed in the city on August 1. |
| Christmas Home Tour | Mr. Bouknight raised the possibility of doing a Cottontown Christmas home tour. |
| Social Committee | Ms. Ligon volunteered to chair a social committee to investigate neighborhood interest and support for these types of events. |

Other Business

Several board members expressed a need for requesting more police enforcement of the no right turns from Bull Street. Mr. Cotner volunteered to call the police department with the request.
